A database of Maori owned/operated dairy farms, managed by DairyNZ, Primary ITO and The Federation of Maori Authorities, is being collated for the overall benefit of Maori dairy farming. A Māori farm is identified as:

1. Farms owned by land owners that are administered by a structure under Te Ture Whenua Māori Land Act, 1993
2. Farms actively managed by Māori; includes entities like iwi authorities and post settlement entities (farms could be on Māori and or general land).
